

Flinders University Course Information

The following is a list of Flinders University courses that are available to UHM students. Students typically select undergraduate courses from these subjects in Levels 1, 2 and 3 (1XXX, 2XXX, 3 XXX) to receive UHM equivalents.

In looking up a course that does not yet have a UHM equivalent at the website, enter the course (and number if known), then hit CALENDAR for the description, and TIMETABLE for the semester it is offered.

Courses which do not have an assigned UHM equivalent must receive approval from the appropriate Mānoa department. A course description, along with a UHMSAC "Semester in Australia" program brochure, must be presented to a qualified department chair or other faculty member. Once this is done, the Flinders courses with the respective UHM equivalents should be listed in a memo addressed to the Study Abroad Center.
